Dear Parents/Guardians

Greetings from Yuying Secondary School!

2 We hope that your child/ward has had a restful and enjoyable December break and that he/she is recharged to return to school. Our students have had a fruitful and enriching 2023 with many activities organised for them. This year promises to be yet another exciting year as we look forward to providing your child/ward with vibrant learning experiences.

First Three Days of School Programme

3 This letter seeks to inform you on the details of the first three days of school, **2 - 4 Jan 2024 (Tue - Thu)**. The school has dedicated time for your child/ward to ease back into school, through the **START RIGHT programme** on these three days. Through this programme, your child/ward will be provided with opportunities to connect with his/her classmates and form teachers and adjust to school routines. 4 Your child/ward must report in the school hall by **7.40 am daily**. Your child/ward is encouraged to reach school earlier and engage in silent reading. You can support your child/ward to ease back into school by re-establishing his/her sleep routine.

5 To ease your child/ward back into school, there will be an attire and grooming check on the first day of school (**2 Jan 2024**). Having proper attire and grooming is an outward expression of one's readiness to learn. Your child/ward must be in half school uniform and his/her hair should be neatly cut and of its natural colour. Students who fail to meet the school's expectations (Student Handbook Pg 8-12) will be sent home to rectify their attire and/or hair before returning to school. You will be informed should your child/ward fail to meet the prescribed attire and/or hair standard. We seek your cooperation and support in partnering us to ensure your child/ward is in the proper attire and hairstyle for school.

Use of Lockers and digital locksets

6 Each student will be given a Digital lockset and a locker to store their Personal Learning Device (PLD) during curriculum time when not in use. All students are expected to bring their Personal Learning Device (PLD) home. PLDs must not be left in the lockers overnight. The digital lockset which is given on loan to the student will need to be returned to the school on the last day of school in 2024. Should a student lose his/her digital lockset, the student needs to replace by purchasing it at the school bookshop.

Temperature-taking Exercise

7 As part of our continued preparedness for school emergencies, our school will be conducting a temperature-taking exercise on **10 Jan 2024**. Your child/ward must bring a working Oral Digital Thermometer (ODT) for the exercise from **5 Jan 2024** onwards. This is an opportunity for your child/ward to practise social responsibility.
