Greetings from Yuying Secondary School! We would like to warmly welcome you and your child/ward to our school. This letter seeks to provide useful information as your child/ward prepares to join us for Secondary 1:

A) Communication

- 2. Your child's/ ward's Form Teachers will be making a courtesy call to you by Tuesday, 23 Dec 2025. If you miss the call and would like to be contacted, please call the **General Office at 62827968** so that our teachers can return your call.
- 3. If there are any further queries, please do not hesitate to contact your child's Form Teacher, the General Office or email us at yuying.ss@moe.edu.sg. The school will communicate with parents primarily via Parents Gateway (PG) going forward.

B) First Day of School

5. The school year will begin on Friday, 2 January 2026. Students are to report to school by 7.30 a.m. and will be dismissed at 12.40 p.m. More details regarding the first week of school and the secondary school curriculum will be shared in a separate PG message on Monday, 29 December 2025.

C) Financial Assistance

D) School Uniform and Textbooks

- 7. Students may purchase their school uniforms, textbooks and stationery in person at Yuying Secondary School. They may do so strictly by appointment only on 23, 26, 29 Dec 2025 (9.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m.) or 30 Dec (9.00 a.m. to 12.00 p.m.).
- 8. A separate PG message will be sent to you to make an appointment to purchase the school uniform and textbooks. Please note that there will be no trying of uniforms and students are to bring a best-fitted garment to compare and select the size. Payment for the uniform and textbooks can be made using cash or NETS. You may refer to the following link on the school website for information on the textbooks:

E) Offer to take subjects at a higher level via Subject Based Banding (SBB)

- 9. Students who are eligible to take subjects at a more demanding level (MDL) will be informed via PG. Parents are to indicate their preference on whether to accept or reject the offer(s) via PG. Hardcopy letters of offer will only be given to students without PG on the first day of school (Friday, 2 Jan 2026). The signed letter of offer should be returned to the Form Teachers the following week. Please note that if students are taking up the offer, they should purchase the correct textbooks.

F) Mother Tongue Language (MTL) Matters

11. Please note the following details about Mother Tongue Languages:

a) Higher Mother Tongue Language (HMTL)

- Students who are eligible to take HMTL will be informed via PG. Should they take up the offer, they would need to purchase the correct HMTL textbooks/workbooks.
- **Higher Chinese Language** lessons will be conducted within curriculum time.
- Higher Tamil Language (HTL) and Higher Malay Language (HML) lessons will be conducted at designated language centres after school.
 - o HTL designated centre: Umar Pulavar Tamil Language Centre
 - o HML designated centre: MOE Language Centre

b) Tamil Language (TL)

• TL lessons will be conducted at Umar Pulavar Tamil Language Centre.

c) Students taking Asian Languages (Thai/Burmese)/Foreign Language (French/German/Japanese) in lieu of MTL

- For students who took Asian/Foreign languages in lieu of MTL at primary school, he/she has to continue taking it at secondary school.
- There is no need to submit a re-application to obtain approval at the secondary school level to take Asian/Foreign Language in lieu of MTL. Students are required to continue with private study arrangements.
- More information will be provided for students taking Asian / Foreign Language in Week 1 of 2026.

d) Third Languages: Malay (Special Programme), Chinese (Special Programme), Bahasa Indonesia, Arabic, French, German, Japanese and Spanish

- Students who have applied to take a third language will be notified of their application outcomes via PG. Both successful and unsuccessful applications will be notified.
- Students who have been offered Malay (Special Programme) or Chinese (Special Programme) by the zonal centres must register online at the respective zonal centre websites to accept the offer. Students who have been offered to take a Foreign Language must register with MOE Language Centre to accept the offer.
- 12. Once again, a warm welcome to Yuying Secondary School. We look forward to receiving your child on the first day of school next year!
